The implementation of OneImpact-Gaza by ADPP, is carried out in partnership with AMIMO, under the leadership and guidance of the National TB Program. ADPP and AMIMO have had their first meeting to define areas of operations, as well as the training package that will be devoloped by NAMATI. The meeting was followed by an agreement signature between ADPP and NAMATI. The TOT in health human rights will be carried out within the coming weeks by NAMATI.



The TB Community Led Monitoring activities, patients centered in rural populations of Gaza, is now an assumed commitiment of the districts governaments. A belief of Gaza free from TB has commited local radios in this batle.



OneImpact –Gaza (Mozambique), it's a TB Community-Led Monitoring program implemented by ADPP, which aims to transform the TB response to be equitable rights-based and patients centered. The platform fearlessly gives voice to TB patients to express their concerns under the accessibility, aceptability, availability and quality of TB services. OneImpact-Gaza has been presented to four commuity local radios (Radio Xai-Xai, Chibuto, Mazivila and Chokwé) last week, which will be at the forefront towards it's promotion in the targeted districts. It has been agreed to broadcast OneImpact activities once per quarter.
